DOG'S STORY Mary Oliver

I have a bed, my very own. It's just my size. And sometimes I like to sleep alone with dreams inside my eyes.

But sometimes dreams are dark and wild and creepy, and I wake and am afraid, though I don't know why. But I'm no longer sleepy and too slowly the hours go by.

So I climb on the bed where the light of the moon is shining on your face and I know it will be morning soon.

Everybody needs a safe place.

Beatrice was a 100 and some pound Mastiff/Pyrenees mix who, along with my current dog Ben, protected all the animals on our homestead near Blanchardville. We lost her, at the ripe age of 12, just a couple of years ago. She is pictured here curled up on the bed belonging to my daughter's 10-pound poodle.

The poem alongside the picture is one of my favorites from Mary Oliver's <u>Dog Songs</u> collection. What I love about Oliver's poetry is her skill in turning the ordinary into a deep expression of the extraordinary. She does that here with the closing line, "*Everybody needs a safe place*."

Being a welcoming church means being a community that creates a "safe place" for people who, often for very good reasons, have never felt safe in a church. This is not as easy as we often think. Printing "Everyone Is Welcome" in your bulletin each week or on your church sign is not enough. Every church in the country *says* they welcome everybody, but far, far too often they are not really telling the truth.

Creating a safe place for everyone requires intentional effort, cooperation, listening to each other, and sometimes stepping out of our comfort zone. It requires, in fact, nothing less than the Fruit of the Spirit, as St Paul describes it in Galatians 5: "Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, and generosity."

Fortunately for the church, this "fruit" is a gift of God's grace. It is abundantly available and able to draw out of us a wide open, generous welcome. A welcome that will be heard *and believed* and will result in changed lives—our own as well those of others who are hoping to find a church home.

This isn't always easy or comfortable. But it is vital. As the book of Hebrews reminds us: "Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it."




