

Dear Consistory,

The season of Pentecost is now upon us - a time when we have the opportunity to open ourselves to the guidance of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is one of the three parts of the triune God – Creator, Christ, and Holy Spirit. Jesus promised his disciples that an advocate, the spirit of truth, would guide them after he departed. The Holy Spirit is what emboldened the apostles in Acts 2 to speak in the different languages of the people gathered for the Pentecost Festival in Jerusalem and for Peter to deliver the best sermon ever offered. On that day 3,000 people were baptized and the Christian Church was born. The work of the Holy Spirit continues even today, pushing us and prodding us to continue this vital ministry that began 2,000 years ago. The season of Pentecost runs until the end of November and the liturgical color traditionally is green, symbolizing spiritual growth and vitality within the life of the church.

I give thanks that the Holy Spirit has led you to this time and place and that you have been inspired to serve on the First UCC consistory. You have been blessed by a most loving God, and you are sharing your blessings in a variety of ways within the life of our faith community. Thanks for all your efforts to make the ministry of First UCC the best that it can be.

In terms of my report:

- 1.) The United Church of Christ General Synod meeting in Milwaukee June 21-25. This is the national meeting of our denomination and it occurs every two years. I plan to attend Synod for the day on Friday June 21 and on the "All Church Day" on Sunday June 23. Sixteen people from First UCC have signed up to travel to Milwaukee for the "All Church Day". A charter bus will transport members of the Baraboo UCC, Columbus UCC and Sauk City UCC to this event. The bus departs Olivet Congregational UCC in Columbus at noon and we should get back to Columbus between 8-9pm.
- 2.) I lead worship at the Pines (3pm) and the Pine Villa (3:30pm) on June 20.
- 3.) Church fellowship outing at the Madison Mallards game on Saturday July 27. Game starts at 6:05pm and the First UCC Tailgate begins at 4pm in the parking lot. We have a block of 20 tickets and they cost \$12 apiece.
- 4.) First UCC youth had two fundraisers throughout the spring to defray costs related to the January 2019 youth retreat in the Dells. Even with the fundraisers, we are still in the hole financially regarding the 2019 retreat. I will be making a formal request to Mission Possible, our fundraising ministry, for help to cover the rest of the youth retreat expenses.
- 5.) I have sent out a letter to First UCC high school and college students promoting the <u>June 20-28, 2020</u> trip to Back Bay Mission and the <u>2020/2021 German youth exchange</u>. I am hopeful to have Sauk City youth participate in either of these opportunities. I will be leading the youth exchange and we are tentatively scheduled to be in Germany June 22 July 14, 2020 and the Germans will be with us in Wisconsin July 7-28, 2021.
