

Committee Reports:

Building & Maintenance: (1) Women's restroom remodel in Fireside room. Discussed proposed layout, space, ADA requirements, electrical. Single, handicapped stall, new door with lock, unisex for accessibility. (2) Crack in plexiglass in church repaired. (3) Stained glass windows - fundraiser exceeded goal. Able to also work on smaller window. (4) Parking lot resurface - Village to re-do handicap/wheelchair symbols as too small. (5) Two new toilets for restrooms in back of church and water heater.

<u>Christian Fellowship:</u> (1) Gathering/Meal, no new business to report.

<u>Finance:</u> No meeting scheduled at this time.

<u>Members in Ministry:</u> Actively making visits and taking communion to shut-ins, nursing homes, and hospitals weekly. They will


