Rain or Shine, come & dine with us in the Park Shelter or pick up some orders to go. Thank you for your support!



I enjoy the summer months for a variety of reasons. July is a wonderful time to be enjoying the great outdoors – whether it be biking, hiking, swimming, etc. It's a time of vacation and rejuvenation for families. Some of our vital ministries such as the Sunday school, adult education, confirmation, choir and contemporary worship take a break during the summer months to rest and refocus for the upcoming 2019-2020 program year.

I'm thankful that in spite of these slower moments in the life of the church, you are actively plugged in to what's going on at First UCC this summer. I've seen you at worship, attending committee meetings and working around the church. I greatly appreciate your efforts.

#### In terms of my report:

- A.) First UCC Fellowship Night at the Madison Mallards game is Saturday July 27. We have 16 spots open as of now. The game starts at 6:05pm and a tailgate begins at 4pm in the parking lot.
- B.) Sauk Prairie Against Hunger food pack event is October 24-26, 2019. We usually have a mixed generation group of 20-25 people who participate on the first day of the event, which will be Thursday October 24 at 6:30pm. I will plan to register our group when registration opens 9/15.
- C.) We are scheduled to serve the meal at *The Crossing* on November 17. Set up is at 5:30pm and we serve the meal at 6pm. They are trying at new format this year, holding their worship on Wednesday nights and having a small group night on Sunday evenings (a time to offer students several opportunities to grow in faith and in community). Their small group time is 5pm-6pm.
- D.) Thanks to *Project Mission Possible*, our church fundraising ministry, for covering the remainder of the costs associated with the 2019 youth retreat. The donation was much needed and greatly appreciated. The next Youth retreat Feb. 14-16, 2020.
- E.) The next *Project Mission Possible* food stand at the Badger Steam and Gas Engine club is scheduled for August 16-18. We need members of the congregation to sign up for a variety of shifts over the Fri/Sat/Sun event. Members can earn \$10 an hour for any non-profit of their choice. Funds raised at this event go on to fund a variety of projects around the church and the wider Sauk Prairie community.
- F.) I have two weddings on the schedule Kelly wedding March 20, 2020 at church and Perry wedding May 30, 2020 at The Wilderness Resort.
