An open letter to our LGBTQ friends, their families and allies

Dear Friends,

We want our welcome to include you.

In past years, with some exceptions of course, much of the Christian church has not treated you well. We have been quick and persistent in our judgment and condemnation. We have pushed you out of our congregations. We have said you were broken or sinful or diseased or otherwise unsuited for our company. We have suggested that you pray more, or more sincerely; that if you did so God would remove from you the affliction we found so objectionable. We have told your parents to evict you and your friends to reject you. In short, the behavior manifested by too many Christians has been unconscionable, if not unforgivable.

And yet, we are humbly asking your forgiveness. We have sadly misrepresented God, whom we claim to serve, and Jesus, whom we claim to follow. We have denied the gospel of Jesus—what we refer to as the good news that calls us to love and respect and support all people.

We are speaking only for ourselves here, although there are many other Christian people in our community who would agree. We are sorry for the pain and suffering the church has caused—and in many settings continues to cause. We ask for the forgiveness we do not deserve.

Recently, the members of First United Church of Christ—Sauk City chose to become an Open and Affirming congregation within the larger United Church of Christ. We want to offer an unqualified rejection of the judgment that has been aimed at the LGBTQ community— wherever it has come from in the past and wherever it continues today. The Bible does not condemn you, nor your families, and neither do we. We will stand with you against hatred, fear and bigotry. And we offer you an unqualified welcome into this church family whenever you feel this could benefit you.

We are committed to being a gathering of Jesus' followers who refuse to draw lines to exclude anybody. So if you need a place of safety and welcome in Sauk City, a place to serve God and to stretch your spirit, a place to learn and to grow and from which you can bless the world, we will be here to help you and to receive your help in return.

At the very least, we want you to know you already are, and always have been, a beloved child of God. You are not broken. You are not in need of repair (anymore than the rest of us, anyway) and we would be happy to count you as friends and fellow travelers on the way.

It is hard to fathom we're more than halfway through 2022. I am pleased that we have been able to once again begun singing hymns during worship. As we move into August we will continue to monitor the effects of the new variants and whether we can continue to sing hymns and whether First Choir can again sing live during worship. Fingers crossed!

Over the past years I have frequently been asked if I prefer playing organ or piano. It is an interesting question as I didn't come to playing organ until much later in life. Unlike my brother, Bob, who studied both organ and piano from a young age, I didn't take up the organ until I was in my 50s. With that said, I find it difficult to choose my favorite. For some music, especially worship music, the organ is my absolute favorite. On the other hand, in some cases, piano versions of worship music allow for more variety and perhaps even the possibility for greater interpretations. It is a reality that fewer and fewer people are choosing to take up the organ. I would also suggest that fewer children are studying piano given the greater variety of activities available to youth today. When I was a child, there were at least 4 active piano teachers serving the Sauk Prairie area.

In our house alone, every week 15 to 25 students came for weekly lessons both during the school day and into the evening studying originally with Christine Mickelson and eventually with my brother Bob.

Just recently, I met with the Consistory to share some thoughts about the future of music at First Church. The fact that I will be 72 in December suggests the reality that sometime in the future a new organist/music director will be sought. I have no plans to step away, but being prepared for the future is always a good idea. Back to piano vs.organ. We have seen other churches unable to find an organist .Sometimes the only candidates available will be strictly pianists. It also may be a possibility that the choir director is not the person that plays for worship services.

For the present time, I will continue to alternate between piano and organ depending on how the music selected for worship would best be presented. We are blessed that the organ is a fine instrument that has required little maintenance over the years since it was last refurbished in 2004. Our digital piano with all its settings allow us to explore traditional and new sounds for our worship services.

With September just around the corner, it is my hope that we can again start up First Choir for live worship performances. If the circumstances allow, our first rehearsal will be Wednesday, September 7th at 6:45 PM. We would love to have you join us as we begin this new chapter in making music to the glory of God!




