Thanksgiving is next week and there is much to be grateful for: the joy of home, family and wonderful friends. God has been good and has endowed us with everything we have ever needed. Our lives have been blessed so richly and abundantly.

I'm thankful for the ministry of First UCC Sauk City, WI. We are so fortunate to have such a wonderful congregation made up of faithful, friendly and hard-working people. I'm thankful for you, the lay leaders of our church.

I'm excited for what the future has in store. A new church year (Year A on the revised common lectionary) begins the first Sunday of Advent, December 1.

In terms of my report:

- 1.) Thanks to our confirmation guides, Theresa Grimes and Tom Litscher, for their continued work with our middle schoolers. We are incredibly blessed to have them involved in the life of our church. Nine youth from First UCC (as well as Tom and Theresa) served the meal at *The Crossing* on November 17. I appreciate their efforts.
- 2.) Stewardship Sunday was November 17. Thanks to the stewardship committee for all of their efforts in promoting stewardship in the life of First UCC with announcements, creating the *Time and Talent* sheets, and our recent planned giving seminar. As of now, 52 pledges have been received for 2020 totaling \$111,690. We will continue to receive pledges up until the end of the year. Thanks to everyone who supports the life of First UCC through your time, talents and offerings.
- 3.) Young Ambassadors meeting took place November 17. We will have 3-4 youth from church participating in the Young Ambassadors youth exchange in 2020/2021. My next meeting at the WI Conference office regarding the German partnership is January 8.
- 4.) I lead the worship service at the Maplewood on November 27 at 10am.
- 5.) Salvation Army Bell Ringing Campaign begins on Thanksgiving eve and will continue until Christmas Eve. This is my 15th year coordinating. Five congregations and a variety of individuals and community organizations will be participating this year. First UCC is scheduled to ring the weekend of December 13th and 14th at the Piggly Wiggly in Sauk and Sentry in PdS.
- 6.) Youth Retreat is scheduled February 14-16, 2020. In order to reserve our spaces at the early-bird pricing, we have to register by 12/10. I will need all deposits by Sunday December 8.
- 7.) Carolyn Irene Martin baptism will take place December 8th at the 8am worship service.
