

Your energy and focus gives our ministry a sure direction. Thank you.

#### In terms of my report:

- \*The Windows 7 that I use on my office computer is out of support as of yesterday. My office computer will no longer receive security updates, software updates or tech support. Microsoft strongly recommends using Windows 10 for the latest security features. Cindy has not received this message, so perhaps her computer runs on a different program.
- \*I am participating in the January 26 pulpit exchange as part of the Week of Christian Unity. Shadoe Hanson, student intern at St. John's Lutheran, will lead worship at First UCC during the 8am and 10:30am worship services. I have the fabulous opportunity (once again) to visit the good folk of St. John's Lutheran Leland and Zion Lutheran Rock Springs. I am looking forward to celebrating our ecumenical connections that day. I will also be attending the clergy dinner held at the Green Acres in the evening.
- \*I lead worship at the Maplewood January 30.
- \*Youth Retreat is scheduled for February 14-16 at the Wilderness Resort in the Wisconsin Dells. There are 16 youth (10 girls and 6 boys) and 4 adult chaperones signed up. Kurt Schultz will be leading worship on February 16.
- \*Mission trip is scheduled for June 21-27, 2020 at Back Bay Mission. An organizational meeting needs to be called in the next few weeks. We have a reservation for 18.
- \*Youth exchange trip to Germany June 22-July 13, 2020. We will need to find worship leaders for June 28 and July 5. July 12 worship is still up in the air, as the Germans have not given us a definitive departure date.

#### Open & Affirming Committee January 2, 2020

All members present: Pastor Bill, Shirlee Lendved, Dennis Kahn, Tammie Huerth, Chris Logterman, Barb Sprecher, Dean Sprecher, Christy Kinnamon.

Reviewed notes from previous meetings and questionnaires from congregation. The responses to the questionnaires confirmed our decision to take a slow and cautious approach to the Open & Affirming process. We talked about a perception that the Conference is telling us that we have to work toward becoming Open & Affirming. The Conference is a resource and is supportive and willing to help. They do encourage its member UCC churches to enter this process and to be in covenant with them; however, we make our own decisions, and govern ourselves from the ground up. The origins of our study into Open & Affirming can be traced all the way back to conversations with former Pastor Bob Rieke, and to comments made at an Annual Meeting a few years ago. Most members believe that we are a welcoming church; but the question is, how will we express that welcome. We think that people outside our church need to explicitly see that welcome – and the Open & Affirming process is a way in which we can express that.

A short survey about topics for learning & discussion, suggested formats, and times when people prefer to meet appeared in the January SCOOP. We hope to tally those and come up with whatever works best for most members of the congregation. Those can be dropped off at the church office, at the back of the church after Sunday services, or brought to the Meet & Greet on Sunday, January 19.

The Meet & Greet on January 19 after the 10:30 service will be an opportunity to meet the members of the Open & Affirming Committee. Each of them will share their reasons for serving on the committee, and will respond to general questions about the process. There will be opportunities for more in-depth discussions at future events. Some of those events include a Panel Discussion on February 23, Bible Studies in March & April, Listening Sessions, and guest speakers and clergy.
