Dear Members and Friends of First UCC.

One idea I've been wrestling with for quite a while is how to get a greater percentage of our church members to step inside our church building throughout any given week. Right now we average about 35% of our total membership who steps foot inside First UCC on a regular basis. People step foot in our church for Sunday worship, Christian education, meetings, choir and contemporary worship. I would love to see that number double in the next five years.

I believe that one way to get a greater percentage of our membership involved is by offering Small Group and Family Ministry opportunities in the life of our church. We can help nurture the Christian faith by engaging people in a small group setting.

We can empower our members to create ideas for small groups that meet their spiritual needs or interests. The sky's the limit in terms of different areas we can pursue. Here are a few examples:

If you have a special interest in music, art, Bible study, fellowship, family ministry or mission, then maybe you'd consider participating in (or leading) a small group at First UCC. I would appreciate creating groups that meet the needs of the different demographics of our congregation. These groups could meet on a weekly or monthly basis.

A bonus of having this type of small group and family ministry is that it can be offered to the entire community, not just people connected to our congregation. This is important, as our ministry focus is not just about serving the needs of our own, but to everyone within a one-mile radius of our church. A viable faith community has its focus and energy turned outward, ministering to the needs of people who may or may not be associated with a church.



We all will encounter challenging times during our lives. Whatever the circumstance, we often struggle with how to move forward in the midst of grief and despair.

What does the Bible have to say about grief? How can we develop networks of support and encouragement? How can we be a resource to others who are going through similar circumstances?

Pastor Bill would like to form a grief support group within the life of First United Church of Christ. It is a sorely needed ministry, and he thinks it ought to be made available not just for church members, but for the entire community. He envisions a blend of guided Bible meditation, group discussion, personal sharing and prayer.

GriefShare will start meeting in July on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday mornings at 10am in the downstairs kitchen of the education building.


