### Greetings First United Church of Christ—Sauk City

As you have heard by now, your Church Consistory has invited me to serve as your interim pastor, beginning on the first Sunday of June. This is an invitation I am pleased and honored to accept. At their request, I am sending you this brief introduction.

My name is Brad Brookins. My wife, Lorna, and I live in Mt Horeb with our very big and very hairy retired farm dog, Benedik and a more recently adopted Beagle named Ruby. We have two grown daughters. Our oldest lives in Mt Horeb where she is a free lance writer and operates her own pet sitting business. Our younger daughter is a Mennonite pastor currently working as a chaplain in a Chicago hospital. Lorna works as a (soon to be almost completely retired) Health Unit Coordinator at Meriter Unity Point Hospital in Madison.

Until June of 2020 I was the pastor of the Mt Vernon United Church of Christ, a little ways southeast of Mt Horeb. I retired, for the first time, after serving there for almost 16 years. Before Mt Vernon I served three different UCC churches as interim pastor—two in Fort Atkinson and one up in La Crosse. And after Mt Vernon I was the interim pastor at Immanuel UCC in Darlington for almost a year and a half.


