

Dear Consistory,

Hallelujah! Christ is risen! Easter Sunday is the best day of the year. It is the day of rejoicing as we celebrate Christ's victory over sin and death.

In terms of my consistory report:

- 1.) I'm leading worship at the Pines (3pm) and Pine Villa (3:30pm) on April 25.
- 2.) Compassion Sunday is May 5. The theme of that worship service will focus on the ministry and mission of Compassion International. Our church youth have supported a child in Indonesia for the last 8-9 years.
- 3.) Credo conference May 14-20 in Richmond Virginia. I am still in the process of filling out all of the preparatory paperwork in advance of the meeting. This conference offers the opportunity for participants to reflect on key aspects of their lives (financial, health, spiritual, and vocational) and to discern the future direction of their life and ministry. I will be out of worship Sunday, May 19.
- 4.) There is a music conference I would like to attend in East Troy, Wisconsin July 12-14. There is no cost associated with this event. Wondering if I could have your blessing to not be in attendance at First UCC for worship on July 14 at the 9 AM service? I would be traveling from East Troy on Sunday morning back to Sauk and then back to East Troy after church for the conclusion of the program on Sunday afternoon.
- 5.) I believe it was around Advent 2018 when one of our consistory members suggested giving our church neighbor, Harley Breunig, a gift certificate from McFarlanes' for all of his efforts in the church park. Harley spends a lot of time in the church park mulching the leaves so that they do not blow into his yard. I never did follow through with this until last week, when Mr. Breunig was out in our church park again cleaning up debris/leaves from the winter. He was a little perturbed and disappointed that we have not come up with a better way of keeping the church park in order. Dean and I went over to apologize and I presented him with the \$75 McFarlanes' gift certificate and a \$50 Cenex gas card.
