


Confirmation 2019-2020

We're a little over three weeks out until the beginning of the new program year at First UCC. I'm looking forward to getting our Christian education and music programs going once again, as well as our Wednesday evening contemporary worship services.

I'm appreciative of our church staff: Cindy Baker, Chris Garcia, Dennis Kahn and Margaret McFarlane for all their efforts as we gear up for a new program year. I'm also thankful for our support staff, Sunday school teachers, Sunday school helpers and worship leaders. It really takes a group effort to make our ministry go. I'm grateful for your efforts as a consistory. You are giving your time and efforts, lending your skills and expertise and providing much needed leadership in the life of First UCC. In terms of my report:

- 1.) UEK/UCC Conference Working Group meets at the Wisconsin Conference Office this Wednesday, August 14 from 10am to 1pm. I have been put on this committee to help coordinate the next incarnation of the Young Ambassadors youth exchange scheduled for 2020/2021.
- 2.) The First UCC food stand will be up and running this weekend, August 16-18, up at the Badger Steam and Gasoline Engine Club. This is a wonderful way to earn funds for church initiatives. I'll be working Friday 6am-1pm.
- 3.) As per Finance Committee recommendation (and Consistory approval) Tim Homar and I are signing papers August 18 at 1:30pm with Trustpoint to transfer all existing church funds from our Morgan Stanley Account. This move will protect the church from potential stock market volatility, as we will liquidate the stock and money market assets and transfer into a low expense index fund.
- 4.) I have worship services at The Pines (3pm) and the Pine Villa (3:30pm) on August 22.
- 5.) We have our worship service in the park on August 25. The radio broadcast will be compromised somewhat. Perhaps I'll have to do a recording and run it up to WRPQ in Baraboo.
- 6.) A friendly reminder that I'll be taking my third week of vacation the week of August 26. Kurt Schultz will lead worship on September 1.
