Dear Members and Friends of First UCC,

It is good to be back! The sabbatical time away was an opportunity for me to recharge and rejuvenate both soul and spirit. I'm grateful to the congregation for giving me permission to set down the weight of my pastoral duties in order to pursue self-care and honest reflection. The change of scenery did me good. I let go of a lot of past failures and frustrations and return emotionally and mentally in a much better condition. I am looking forward with excitement and expectation at the 2021-2022 program year ahead.

Change is a part of life that we all deal with at some point. Nothing ever stays the same. I pondered that a lot during my time away. Every day offers the prospect of some sort of change – good or bad. We don't really like it, especially in the life of the faith community. I recall the traditional church joke, "How many UCC members does it take to change a light bulb?", with the punchline always being, "Change? We don't like change..."

And yet, as a result of COVID, we've had to make significant changes at First UCC in order to adapt to the ever-changing environment we have been facing. We use the radio and YouTube to bring worship to those who are wary of public interaction but want to access the church service. When the choir can't sing live during the worship service because of the airborne nature of the virus, they pre-record their anthems. When the congregation, committees and Christian education classes can't meet in person we meet virtually. When we can't offer a sit-down chicken dinner the way we normally do, we offer a drive-thru option instead. We've had to make big changes in order to keep our ministry going.

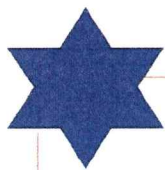
We had even more change recently. A congregational meeting was called in June to discuss the state of the bell tower and approve a restoration project moving forward (which will result in a capital campaign to raise the necessary funds). Two valued staff members, Cindy Baker and Margaret McFarlane, both offered their resignations in July after many years of faithful and distinguished service. We are incredibly appreciative of their dedication to the life of First UCC and their combined 43 years of serving on our church staff. As a result of this transition, things will look a little different in the office and with our Sunday school program.

There is one constant during all of this change – God's steadfast love.

I am reminded of Psalm 46, ***"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change, though the mountains shake in the heart of the sea...The Lord of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge..."***

May God bless you and the ministry of First UCC as we work through transition and change.

Dear Friends,

On July 15, I sent my request to Consistory to accept my resignation as Sunday School Superintendent at First United Church of Christ, effective September 1, 2021. This has been a very hard decision, which I have struggled with for quite a length of time. My work as Sunday School Superintendent is not just a position that I filled...it is my occupation, my calling at my church, how I spend my leisure time, and where I find my camaraderie.

Thirty years ago, I started teaching Sunday School at First U.C.C. when my daughter, Amanda was three. I taught Pre-K for 3 years and then volunteered to be superintendent when Pastor Bob needed someone to take over the position. I was not a member of the church yet, but no one seemed worried. For the next 27 years my ministry continued and I did join the church along the way! My work here allowed me to use my teaching background and kindle my love for sharing God's word. I give thanks to God for His patience in leading me.

What a wonderful journey it has been! What a unique calling to serve in children's ministry. Children are a gift....and leading them to discipleship has been a joy! In the days since I resigned, I have looked over the many pages of class lists. If I counted right, I have had the honor of working with approximately 156 families and 296 students! My heart overflows with the memories of the many students that I had the privilege to share God's love.

I have unending gratitude for all the teachers, church staff, parents, and volunteers that have served alongside me throughout the years. I give thanks for the members in our congregation for all their support. Many, many thanks to Cindy Baker and Chris Garcia who never ceased to amaze me with how much easier they made my job! How blessed I have been to learn from and work with Pastor Bob and Pastor Bill! The knowledge and lessons that I gained from them is unmeasurable! These two outstanding Pastors not only guided me but provided love and laughter along the way! Their friendships with my family will always be treasured!

Moving forward, a succession plan was put into place two years ago, when Brigitta Brickl joined the Sunday School staff as Co-Superintendent. I am confident that the Christian Ministry program here will be in wonderful hands! Christian Education at First U.C.C. will continue full force!

What lies ahead? December is on the horizon and my work with Help Excite Little People will be a priority. I will continue on as coordinator for this project, which is another passion of mine. Amanda has accepted the position of director/teacher of the Sauk Prairie Nursery Center's 4K Program. I look forward to assisting her, as she did for me over the years.

Dear Consistory,

It is good to be back at the church. I have missed the members of this wonderful faith community and my interactions with all of you.

I must admit that it took me a couple of weeks to adjust to not being on my normal routine. A lot of my self-identity is wrapped up in what I do as a pastor, and without my work, I had to re-discover a little bit of who I am as a person and as a child of God. It was a healthy break - for me and for you.

I am grateful to the consistory and to the congregation for this time of renewal. I have heard many positive reviews from summer worship and all of the wonderful people who gave sermons during my time away. As usual, the good folk of this church stepped up and took care of business!

I am excited for the year ahead and the ministry we will accomplish.

In terms of my report:

- a) I ordered confirmation curriculum through Faith Inkubators and put the \$189 charge on the church credit card.**
- b) I will be looking to schedule a mission trip to Back Bay Mission in 2022. Covid derailed our last two attempts at going.**
- c) I have been out of the loop with the Wisconsin Conference UCC but I am assuming that the youth exchange with the Moers Church District in Germany will commence during 2022 and 2023. We have traditionally pulled in youth from our church to participate in these activities and I am hopeful this will happen again.**
- d) I will be checking into youth retreat opportunities for winter/spring 2022. These retreats in the Dells have gotten progressively more expensive through the years and it is getting harder to fund. But our youth have really enjoyed these retreats and we've always had great participation.**
- e) I will be looking to schedule fellowship visits with members of the congregation moving forward. Looking for opportunities to re-connect.**
